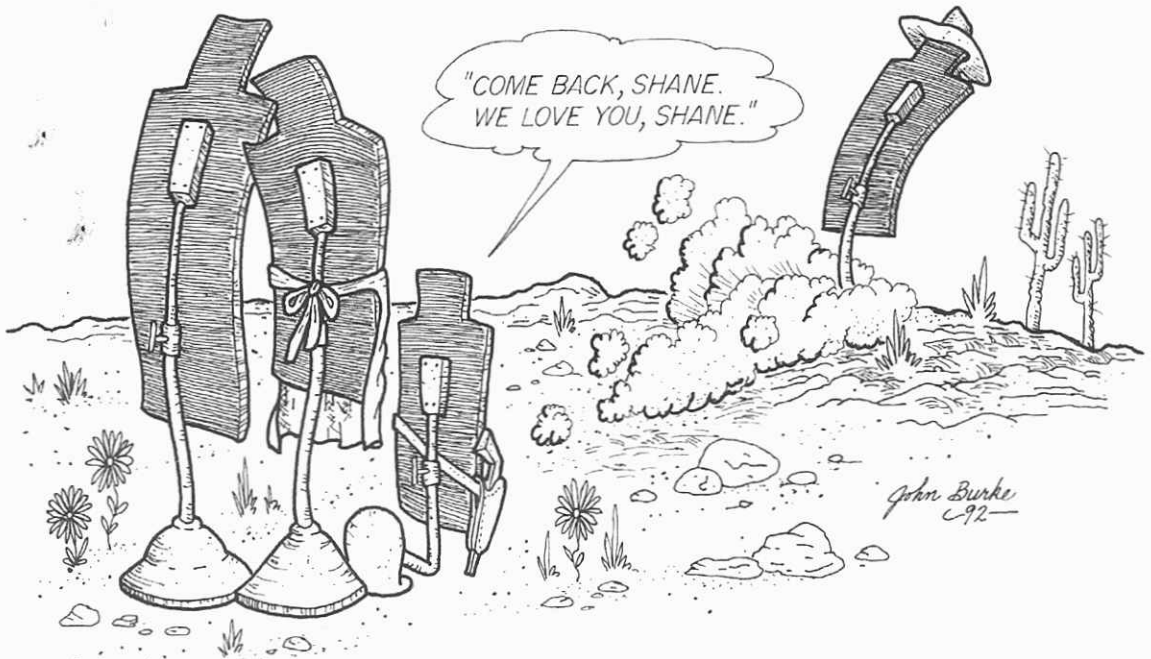

Holsters legal in any of the organizations will be allowed, except no twisting rigs. Maximum allowed time for a shot will be two seconds. Hollywood Division shooters can fan the second shot on Doubles if they so choose. Competitors can shoot in both divisions if they wish.

Non WFDA Fast Draw competitors are invited to compete in this contest if they want to have some fun but they will not be eligible for cash or awards except in the Hollywood Division.

Entry fee each day is \$25 + \$5 WFDA for a total of \$30 each day.

Vice Chairman contests pay out will be Standard Percentages, after expenses.
